Statement on EU RoHS Directive


EU RoHS, the European Union Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive (Directive 2011/65/EU, or “RoHS 2”), restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical or electronic equipment. The Directive was amended by Directive (EU) 2015/863, which increased the list of restricted substances from six to ten (the amended version continues to be called “RoHS 2” or “RoHS 2, as amended”).

We hereby send you information related to EU RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances) Directive (Directive 2011/65/EU), as amended. In accordance with Article 4(3) of the RoHS directive, this communication applies to all products placed on the market by Endress+Hauser.

However, a few instruments are subject to an exemption to the RoHS Directive. They are components of the category ‘large-scale stationary industrial tools’ or ‘large-scale fixed installation’ (Article 2, section 4 (d) and (e)), which are excluded from the directive.

The fulfillment of the RoHS requirements of our products is confirmed by the respective EU declaration of conformity, see www.endress.com/downloads.
