

New China logistics hub in Suzhou

Logistics hub uses modern methods for smooth goods transport

To quickly and reliably supply plants and laboratories with measurement and automation technology, Endress+Hauser strengthened its global supply chain capabilities by opening a new logistics center in Suzhou, China in March 2021.
